Culturally Inclusive Instruction

What does it mean?

Using cultural knowledge, prior experiences, frames of reference, and performance styles of ethnically diverse students to make learning encounters more relevant and effective for them.

Why is it important for our work?

- Our learners are typically the most vulnerable and disadvantaged
- Motivates learners to learn
- More effective training
- Bigger and stronger impact





Best Practices at CTN

- Outreach by bilingual staff / volunteers
- Provide handouts in the learner's language
- Pre-configure devices into the learner's language*
- Instructor who speaks the language
 - Avoid mixing languages in one session
- Instructor who is familiar with and understands the culture


