

Online Voter Registration Guide

1. Are you eligible to vote? You must be:

- A United States citizen,
- A resident of California,
- 18 years of age or older on Election Day,
- Not currently imprisoned or on parole for the conviction of a felony currently, and
- Not found by a court to be mentally incompetent.

2. Are you registered to vote in California? You'll need:

<p>We can register you online! http://registertovote.ca.gov/</p> <p>-Driver's License or California State ID number OR <i>-If you don't have a Driver's license or State ID, you will need to fill out a paper registration card</i></p> <p>-Last 4 digits of SSN <i>-If you don't know this information leave the box blank and the Department of Elections will contact you. Be sure to include your current phone # or email</i></p> <p>**At the end of the registration process you can email or print a PDF confirmation page for your records.</p>	<p>Continue below</p>

3. Do you have a home (residential) address?
